

Large projection screen



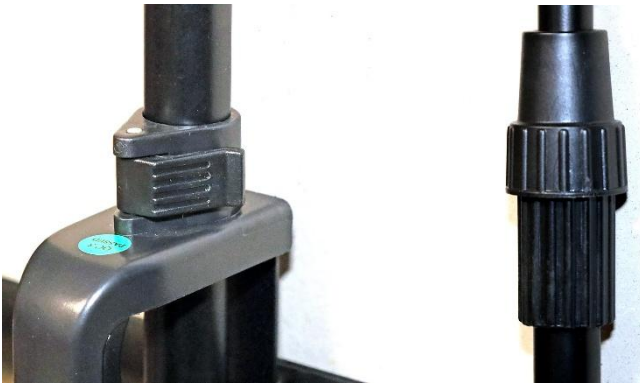
We have recently replaced the screen used by several groups in the Meeting Room at the QMH.¹

The new screen is on a tripod and folds up into a single unit weighing 12 kg – easily carried by one person, with another to hold the doors open. It is stored in the corner of the QMH corridor, where the old screen was kept.



The projection area is 211 cm wide x 160 cm high.

There are two adjustments, shown below:



The lower clamp, shown on the left, has a “click to open and adjust” lever. For the upper clamp, you hold the lower part and twist the upper part to loosen it. This is where it helps to have a second person to support the column.

When standing behind the screen to operate the clamps, the u3a sticker should be the right way up and on your right hand side:

When used with the Acer projector (093) the screen should be 3.4 m from the lens. For a typical projector table height of 80 cm and the screen on its maximum height, you need spacers under the projector’s front feet about 16 cm thick. I have included a couple in the projector bag.
