

Logitech speakers type Z320

L&M u3a owns two pairs of these speakers. They were launched in 2009 to provide good quality sound from a desktop computer, but they have other uses.



The speakers are 19 cm high and are permanently wired in pairs. Each pair has a cable with a 3.5 mm stereo jack that can plug into a computer *headphones* socket. Volume can be adjusted by the knob on the front of the right-hand speaker. Power is provided by a dedicated PSU with an integral 13A plug.

I tested the 059 pair with a Dell XPS computer and it sounded OK for watching a video and loud enough for a room with a dozen people. Not Hi-Fi, but better than many TVs, and better than the sound quality from most of our video projectors.

I then listened to a podcast on my Samsung phone, using a USB-C to 3.5 mm stereo conversion cable (see photo).¹ Good for a room with a dozen or so people, but not loud enough for somewhere the size of the QMH Meeting Room.
